Emerging Wisely Current State: Relaxing Phase 2 – Next Steps

Isolation and Vaccination Information for Returning NWT Students

1. Students returning to the territory must submit a Resident Self-Isolation Plan (<https://www.gov.nt.ca/covid-19/en/services/completing-resident-self-isolation-plan>) prior to returning to the NWT.
2. Self-isolation for 14 days is required on arrival to the Territory.
3. Students may be able to isolate in their own accommodation, provided it has its own entrance, kitchen, and bathroom, or in the family home if all members isolate together. This opportunity is available for students returning to Norman Wells.
4. If family members or room mates are unable to self-isolate with the returning student- please call the Town Office to inquire about alternative housing. Students returning to Norman Wells will not be able to self-isolate in the housing provided by the Town.
5. Adult NWT students are eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine after the 14-day self-isolation period is complete.
6. Students who live in Norman Wells can contact the Sahtú Got'iné Regional Health and Social Services Centre to arrange a vaccination appointment @ 867-587-3333.
7. Students who do not return to the NWT for the summer are unlikely to qualify to get the COVID-19 vaccine in another province or territory where they are not a resident.
