Emerging Wisely Current State: Relaxing Phase 2 – Next Steps

Self-isolation time changes for travelers who are fully vaccinated.

- 1. There is a new opportunity for testing on the eighth day of the 14-day self-isolation period for **fully vaccinated** persons entering the Northwest Territories (NWT).
- 2. Once the Covid test comes back negative, residents will still have to self-monitor for symptoms and wear a mask but will not be required to isolate for the full 14 days.
- 3. Rapid Covid testing is currently available in Norman Wells. Results are available within 24 hours of testing. To schedule an appointment please call 867-587-3333.
- 4. If you are travelling with someone who is not fully vaccinated (including children), unfortunately the new travel exemptions do not apply to you.
- 5. Nonresidents may still receive an exemption from the Chief Public Health Officer to self-isolate in the community. Fully vaccinated nonresidents can take advantage of the new isolation time if they are granted an exemption.
- 6. The Office of the Chief Public Health Officer will also be allowing remote tourism activities to resume under certain conditions.
- 7. NWT Tourism Operators will need to submit a Remote Tourism Operators COVID-19 Operations Plan to the OCPHO for authorization to host out-of-territory clients at remote sites in the NWT.
