GNWT Expands COVID-19 Testing

To slow and contain the spread of COVID-19 it is of utmost importance to diagnose and isolate individuals infected with the virus. As we continue to learn about this new virus we need to reassess and adjust our approach, which includes who we test. Research has shown that individuals with COVID-19 might experience symptoms other than fever, new or worsening cough, or shortness of breath. These include a recent onset of:

A general feeling of unease, or being 'under the weather'

- Muscle aches

- Fatigue

Sore throat

- Runny nose

Headache

- Diarrhea

Vomiting

Loss of smell

The GNWT has expanded its already aggressive testing strategy to include anyone experiencing a recent onset of these symptoms. Residents who are not feeling well are urged to call 8-1-1 or to take the online NWT self-assessment and follow the provided advice. Anyone experiencing severe symptoms such as difficulty breathing, and severe acute respiratory distress syndrome should call 9-1-1.
