Indoor Gathering Restrictions Eased in the NWT

- most events and gatherings with up to 200 people are permitted without any further approvals required.
- some high-risk activities that need additional approvals because they are considered higher risk such as gatherings of more than 200 people; funerals/celebrations of life; live singing; wind instrument performances; indoor dancing; winter sports; and handgames.

GNWT Eases Self Isolation Requirements

- NWT residents, non-resident essential service workers and other travelers with exemptions who are **fully vaccinated** will no longer need to self-isolate upon entry to the NWT.
- Everyone is still required to submit a Self Isolation Plan.
- The recommendation to travel only for essential reasons has also been rescinded.
- Anyone who is **partially vaccinated** is still required to self-isolate for a minimum of 8 days with a day 8 negative test.
- Anyone who is **unvaccinated**, including children under 12, is required to self-isolate for a minimum of 10 days with a day 10 negative test.
- Children under 2 will not be required to get a test on day 10 but only isolate until then.
- For mixed households who are travelling together, it is only the **least vaccinated** traveler(s) who will be required to get a test.
- Household members must follow the same self-isolation guidance as the traveler, regardless of their vaccination status. If vaccination status differs for multiple travelers, the rest of the household must isolate for the longest period.
