## 5. Old Business

- a) Tourism Operator Licensing
  - Member Hunter provided an explanation of Tourism Licensing in the NWT (application process, safety plans, consultation process). He noted that having this licensing opens the door to more funding and is of enormous value to the Community. There is also funding available for a Tourism Coordinator (available every two years). The Tourism Coordinator should have experience in the industry or have Tourism training. The Tourism Fund through ITI can be used for this position (see brochure). Kacee mentioned that the under serviced areas of Tourism in Norman Wells include extreme outdoor adventures such as mountain biking, quadding, rocking climbing etc. He would also like to see partnerships with other communities. Once the all-season road opens there will be an influx of general travel into the community, and we need to be ready for it. Having a Tourism Coordinator would help the Town prepare for the influx of tourism. Norman Wells should be the

main stop for Tourists who are getting ready for their trips into the mountains and around the region.

  - Isaiah had told Kayla that he was impressed with the respondent rate, especially with the Youth Survey.
