 - Stay home: Although you might feel as though you're sitting around doing nothing, staying
 home is the best thing you can do right now. Not only will it keep you safer, but it'll also protect
 those, especially the vulnerable (kids/elders).
 - Check on other people: Call your friends and neighbours to check on them. You might find an
 elderly neighbor isn't aware that they can have their groceries delivered. Or you may discover a
 friend needs some emotional support.
 - Make some deliveries: If you have the extra time or hands, consider doing a grocery run for someone. Just leave the groceries on their doorstep. Call the Northern Store or Ramparts and see if they need help packing or delivering groceries.
 - Volunteer for the safety squad: The safety squad is responsible for ensuring gathering restrictions are adhered to high-risk areas in town such as the Northern Store, Liquor Store and Ramparts. Call the Emergency Response Coordinator at 867-445-9114.
 - Donate: to the Free Pantry which is located on the steps of the Town Office. Any dry and nonperishable food items will be happily accepted!
