State of Local Emergency

Although the containment order from the OCPHO has expired, the state of local emergency and curfew remain in effect until Friday, September 17, 2021 at 11:59pm.

Curfew

Emergency Measures By Law section 15e states that “curfew will come into effect upon activation of the Emergency Measures Organization”. When the state of local emergency expires, the Emergency Measures Organization will no longer be active.

Mandatory Masking

Indoor Public Places:

- Effective 08:00 am August 26,2021 the CPHO issued a Public Health Order mandating wearing of Masks in all indoor public places across the NWT. This order remains in effect for the entire NWT.

Recommendations

Gatherings:

- While gatherings are once again allowed it is wise to keep your bubble small.

Symptoms:

- Self monitor for Covid-19 symptoms for yourself as well as your dependents. Anyone experiencing symptoms should isolate immediately and call the Health Center for Medical Direction and Testing. This is especially important with school starting tomorrow.

Physical Distance:

- Keeping a safe physical distance of 2m (6 feet) is still a best practice to prevent spread of COVID – 19, this practice is recommended.

Handwashing:

- Handwashing throughout the day helps to limit spread of COVID-19.

Town Owned Facilities

The fitness center will open Saturday, September 18, 2021. The five-person limit will remain in place until further notice. Please follow all social distancing and masking protocols while using the fitness center.
