## **Emerging Wisely Current State:** Step by Step Together

## **Explanation of 12am-6am Curfew:**

- Community Accomplishments:
  - There has been a decrease in positive Covid-19 cases.
- There is solid evidence of community transmission which can be caused by as little as 1 individual who does not comply with public health orders.
- We know that there is community transmission because of the wastewater signal. The
  wastewater indicates that there are many unidentified cases of covid-19 in the
  community.
- Chief Public Health Officer concerns include:
  - Wastewater signal.
  - The number of individuals reported not complying with CPHO directives.
- The curfew is not expected to solve all problems; however, it will help.
- The attached chart shows that Norman Wells has around **4400 copies per ml** of covid-19 in the wastewater. Wastewater sampled is of those who are on the utilidor, this does not include trucked water residents.
- See also attached a copy of the wastewater chart from Yellowknife. Even at their peak
  of 52 active cases, wastewater signal is indicating under 100 copies per ml of covid-19.
