TOWN OF NORMAN WELLS

BY-LAW NO. 21-17 Repeals 17-06

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NORMAN WELLS IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT, LEVY AND COLLECTION OF CHARGES FOR GARBAGE COLLECTION SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE MUNICIPALITY, PURSUANT TO THE CITIES, TOWNS, & VILLAGES ACT, S.N.W.T., 2004, PART 4

WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Norman Wells provides for domestic garbage collection, and

WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Norman Wells maintains a site for the proper disposal of all garbage generated and collected from within its boundaries, and

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to levy certain fees for the provision of these services, and

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to provide penalty provisions for those persons who fail to abide by the provisions of this By-Law;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council for the Town of Norman Wells, in a meeting duly assembled, enacts as follows:

 That all property owners or occupiers registered to receive water and sewer services shall be assessed a monthly levy as follows:

> Residential Water and Sewer Users All Other Water and Sewer Users

\$30.00 per month \$40.00.per month

- 2. That all businesses or institutions shall make their own financial and equipment arrangements for garbage collection and disposal in Wildlife-proof containers. Businesses shall be those entities known to carry-on business in Norman Wells, or are licensed as a business in Norman Wells, or are assessed as commercial in the assessment roll of the Town of Norman Wells. Approved home occupations are not included as businesses for the purposes of this By-Law.
- 3. Where it is found that garbage emanating from a business property has not been properly collected or disposed of in keeping with the requirements of this By-Law, that business shall:
 - a) Receive a notice to comply with this BY-LAW forthwith.
 - b) Should compliance not be affected, the Town of Norman Wells shall collect and remove the garbage at the expense of the offending party.
 - c) The business owner may be charged for the offence of noncompliance each day that the offence continues.
- 4. By-Law No. 17-06 is hereby repealed.
- 5. This By-Law shall come into effect upon receiving third reading.
