a) 2023 Operational Budget First Reading

- Administration is not recommending a residential or commercial tax increase at this time but would like an
 assessment done on the current tax model. The SAO also recommended looking into a potential reclamation or
 remediation mill rate.
- The SAO also noted that there has not been a residential tax increase during her tenure.
- The water rate increase averages an additional \$15 per month per household.
- Councillor McCoy noted that small increases to fees and taxes are better instead of one large increase in a few years
- Second reading of the draft budget will take place on Tuesday, December 6, 2022.
