School Student Scholarship Application

The Town of Norman Wells Post-Secondary and Trade School Scholarship Program is intended to provide financial support to Norman Wells residents pursuing post-secondary or trade school studies.

Students enrolled in Degree Program are eligible for up to \$3,000.00 in funding, with up to \$10,000.00 in dedicated funding allocated annually.

Degree Program means an integrated course of study leading to an academic degree.

Students enrolled in a Trade-Diploma Program are eligible for \$3,000.00 in funding, with up to \$10,000.00 in dedicated funding allocated annually.

Trade-Diploma Program means a program of study that leads to the granting of a diploma, certificate, or involves a trades or apprenticeship program.

Applicant Responsibilities

In the application, applicants shall outline how they meet the following criteria:

- a. Norman Wells Residency
(Resident of Norman Wells means an applicant who normally resides in Norman Wells);
- b. Financial need;
- c. Participation in a work experience program or other work placement program (applicable for Diploma Program only);
- d. Academic achievement; and shall
- e. Submit a non-family character reference

Note: Students may apply, or re-apply, for the scholarship each year that they are enrolled in university, college, trades or apprenticeship programs.
